Deaf Arts Festival (DAF) was founded in 2001 with the goal of educating and celebrating the arts by exhibiting diverse, quality visuals and performing arts produced by Deaf Artists themselves. In 2001, DAF successfully established their first festival at Holley Family Village in Brooklyn, Michigan. For the next 11 years, DAF held 5 more festivals bi-annually. In 2012, Arts Beats and Eats invited Deaf Arts Festival to display their Artists along with other juried artists. This will be DAF's 5<sup>th</sup> year partnership with ABE.
